In spite of a year of very low inflation, food costs, power costs and staff wages at Ackworth have all increased this year, not forgetting the VAT increase. This means that the cost of running the Easter Gathering at school continues to increase year on year and unfortunately, in an attempt to ensure that the gathering does not run at a loss, the costs for Easter 2010 have had to be increased to account for this.

In previous years we have offered the facility for day visitors to book meals on the day with no limit on the number who can do this. As explained in the Annual Report, all those who have pre-booked meals will be admitted into the dining-rooms first - those not booked in may still be able to eat, but will have to wait until everyone else has been served and take the chance that they may not have much choice of meal, if any at all.
